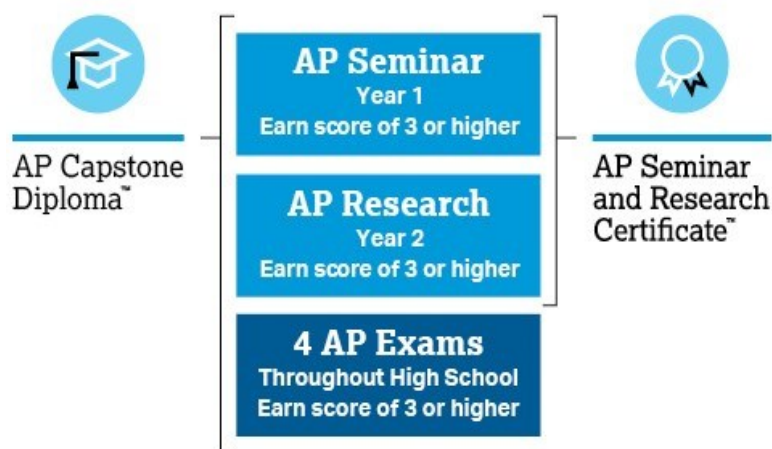

AP Capstone™ *Seminar*

The goal of AP Seminar is to engage students with curricula that is college-level and rigorous with a focus on core academic skills essential for successful college completion. Activities and assignments will reinforce students' capabilities to synthesize information from multiple perspectives and apply skills in cross-curricular contexts and in unfamiliar circumstances. Students will be able to gather and analyze information with accuracy and precision. Students will develop abilities to craft, communicate, and defend evidence-based arguments. Students will be provided with opportunities to practice disciplined and scholarly research skills applied to relevant topics of their interest and curiosity.

AP Capstone™ *Research*

AP Research is the second course in the **AP Capstone™** program. AP Seminar is a prerequisite for AP Research. If you earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research and on four additional AP Exams of your choosing, you will receive the **AP Capstone Diploma™**. This signifies outstanding academic achievement and attainment of college-level academic and research skills. Alternatively, if you earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research only, you will receive the **AP Seminar and Research Certificate™**.
